- Managing O&M requirements to EPC procurement with support from the global back-office team.
- Ensuring the execution of relevant analyses such as O&M concepts, identification of O&M harbours, crew logistics, synergy assessments, and cost drivers for offshore wind O&M.
- Managing local stakeholders and driving O&M supply chain development activities.
- Developing country-specific solutions for the specific project based on general PEAK Wind best practices.
